Haywood County Solid Waste

Haywood County Solid Waste has now completed the move to a Public/Private Partnerships in current solid waste operations with the Material Recovery Facility now being operated by Consolidate Waste Services, who had previously provided hauling and convenience center management since 2010. The White Oak Landfill has been operated by Santek since 2011.

Francis Farm Landfill: The cap maintenance is nearing completion. Nearly 43,000 cubic yards were placed on the top raising the cap 13 to 15 feet in elevation. The Shelton property stockpile has been completed.

Through the purchase of the property and movement of gas monitoring wells to the facility boundary, the facility is now in compliance with gas migration at the boundary.

Assessment of Corrective Measures for the ground water issues will be presented in 3rd quarter of 2016. Any anticipated construction at FFLF would not take place until 2018 or 2019.



Convenience Centers: Mauney Cove and Fines Creek upgrades should be completed by July 2016.

Several other sites will be upgraded next year.

We continue searching for a site on Hwy 209.

Upgraded oil containment systems were placed at three centers. Plan to upgrade another three or four centers next year.

White Oak Landfill: Santek has been operating the landfill since 2011. WOLF is regulated by the NCDEQ with inspections. The County monitors the facility on a regular basis.

No availability fee increase is needed for the next budget year.
