
A Little About Me

Our school board is closing schools while claiming "Raleigh isn't giving enough funding to help keep them open, yet during the democrats reign over our state the budget and pay was much less and we didn't hear any complaints. In fact, the Republicans have increased school spending, as this graph shows.



Clearly, something else is at work here, and if elected I plan to get to the bottom of these issues. In mid-July it was announced that 15 teachers were leaving Haywood County for positions in Buncombe because of higher pay. How exactly can Buncombe County,

How can we expect to teach our students when we can't keep quality teachers here? Also, the County Commissioners do supplement the school system with money, but they use a funding formula that is broken. While its been reported that our schools have students that are literally homeless, our commissioners, instead of helping out with things that matter, have decided to build a 3 MILLION dollar animal shelter. If elected I will push the commissioners to support things that actually matter and make a difference down the road.
