The second is C-2. Someone neglected to include the Free Speech disclaimer!

Pursuant to Proper Etiquette and N.C.G.S. § 14-196.3, this e-mail conforms to Section (e) which applies to any peaceable, nonviolent, or nonthreatening activity intended to express political views or to provide lawful information to others. This section shall not be construed to impair any constitutionally protected activity, including speech, protest, or assembly.

These e-mails comprise Political Satire, Fully Protected Free Speech.

Debbie King is an elected official. Therefore, her threshold for political satire is set at a lower level than someone that is not an elected official. Lynda Bennett and her husband, Pat Bennett, are also elected officials. This lawsuit is hogwash, and needs to have a motion to dismiss.
