ERRORS, OMMISSIONS AND IRRELEVANT MATTERS

WHILE LEAFING THROUGH PLAINTIFF'S legal argument, it was noticed that a few errors were made in the quoting of authorities; in order to maintain an orderly approach with professionalism to our assigned tasks, it is necessary to point these out to Counsel for Plaintiff:

The case of Nguyen V Taylor is only de minimisaly familiar to this one in which we're engaged AND That factor is not highlighted in any manner. In fact, the "appropriation" contained in both is only in the word.

- 1. A case that involves 40 Million \$ can hardly be mentioned in the same breath with one that offers at most, less than 13 of the infamous exhibits, prepared by whom? Moreover, any case that determines over \$10 million in punitive damages is proper is NOT on all fours with Ms. King's case; they use one word that is common...appropriation, which is used liberally in other cases not involving a violation of Privacy. In conclusion, to compare an acorn to a giant oak is ludicrous.
- 2. While Justice Calabria is certainly a learned and able deliverer or interpreter of North Carolina statues, laws and authority, she was nor is involved in either of the cases Plaintiff quoted; Her name has no place in Plaintiff;s Brief and one wonders if something was missed;
- 3. The second case mentioned has no connection or relationship to the issues of this trial; one wonders why it is In said Memorandum; perhaps to test my reading and retention skills? To take a 25 plus page case that goes into detail on subjects of libel, slander, defamation, "false" light: as well as the 4 types of Invasion of Privacy, propounded by Prosser, into a cited case for this case, admittedly presented as an appropriation, is pitiful.
