Ms. King said it was a Conspiracy to keep Denny out of Office, and was begging me to contact the North Carolina Board of Elections and file a formal complaint accusing them of wrong doing.

I did some checking and found out this was a high school student who had run away from home and was cold and broke the church window to get warm of find a blanket, the Canton PD and the Haywood Sheriff investigated, the Haywood Board of elections was called and also investigated and I was told the voting machines' had not been tampered with. I did not file any complaint. I relayed this information to Ms. King, but she refused to change her mind, got even more upset, and stated on the phone that it was a good thing that Denny had been cheated out of the Election because she had information that the County Commissioners had planned to have Denny King Assassinated if he had won the election. Ms. King was in tears and appeared to me to be in extreme emotional destress.

Oddly enough at the next GOP meeting Ms. King was laughing and acting very happy.

That the conduct of exposing the pleadings and discovery and its attendant commitments has been done to unreasonably annoy, harass, and been offered in an attempt to embarrass and oppress the Plaintiff and deny her access to the Courts for the harm caused to her including a posting that all she has to do is step down as Vice Chair of the County Party and this would all be over.

### WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays the Court as follows:

- 1. For an Order suspending the Plaintiff's duty to answer the Defendant's Interrogatorics and Request for Admissions.
- 2. In the alternative, a discovery order protecting the Plaintiff's privacy during litigation for public documents.
- 3. That the Court limit the scope of discovery.
- 4. That discovery be conducted with only the parties and the same sealed to only be opened by the Court.
- 5. For reasonable attorney's fees to be awarded for the Defendant's filing of discovery in violation of the North Carolina General Rules of practice, specifically Rule 1.2.
- 6. For such other and further relief as the court may deem proper.
