NOW COMES the undersigned pursuant to North Carolina Rule 24 of the Rules of Civil procedure and moves the Court for permission to intervene as a party plaintiff in this action on the following grounds;

- 1. That on April 2nd 2018 the locks at the Plaintiffs business were changed and the Defendant had no key or access to the premises and had no permission to be on the premises of the Law Firm, and the property was posted.
- 2. That the Defendant has heretofore admitted that the locks where changed and that she knew that at the time, and she had no key which gave rise to her wrongful entry into the premises.
- 3. The Defendant without permission, just cause or right, took and removed a 700 Samsung computer belonging to Mclean Law Firm P.A. which had been purchased in the year 2013.
- 4. After a Lawsuit was filed against the Defendant as set forth in this matter herein and an order entered in by the Honorable Judge Donna Forga, the Sherriff's Office of Haywood County located the Plaintiff's computer and seized the same.
- 5. That the computer was located at the Defendant's previous residence at the Maggie Valley Inn, and conference center (room 205). The computer was then seized by the Sheriff's department and placed into evidence with the Sheriff's department.
- 6. Thereafter pursuant to an order entered by the Honorable Judge Donna Forga, a company known as New Meridian mirrored imaged the files belonging to Mclean Law Firm P.A. which included trust accounts belonging to the Plaintiffs clients as well as computer files

in the name of the Intervener and the Defendant and other files that where placed on that computer by the named Defendant.

- 7. Since May the 25th 2018 the Intervener has been unable to access 3 files belonging to the Intervener as well as files belonging to the Defendant named herein.
- 8. The Intervener has attempted through communication with the Plaintiffs' lawyer and with the program known as Quick books to locate the administrative password or to change the password, which Quick Books has refused to change the password without permission of the Defendant or sufficient documentation to establish that the Defendant is no longer the responsible party having access to the password.
- 9. That the Intervener is in need of obtaining the information contained on the files which are subject to the Defendant, s administrative password.
- 10. The Petitioner herein named has no way of securing the passwords necessary to access to the computer files on the mirror imaged program delivered to the undersigned by New Meridian without the Defendants password access to those programs.
- 11. That the applicant for Intervention has in this action common facts which would provide facts in common with the Plaintiff's use of its corporate files and a common question of fact in that the administrative password is common to all files contained thereon on the said computer program.

WHEREFORE, having fully prayed the applicant requests the following:

- 1. For an Order permitting him to intervene in this action as an individual.
- 2. That the petitioner be allowed to file a complaint in this action to recover access to his property.
- 3. The cost of this action be taxed to the Defendant.
- 4. For such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
