**Answer:** No ones Voter Registration Number (VRN) is printed on their Ballot.

• Where these ballots sent to the State Board of Elections? What form was voting information tabulated and sent to the State, i.e., scanned copy of ballot, electronic version of ballot, etc.?

**Answer:** Ballots <u>are not</u> sent to the State Board of Elections. <u>Vote Totals</u> are tabulated on each DS200 Voting Machine. <u>Vote Totals</u> are uploaded electronically to <u>Election Results Dashboard</u> on the North Carolina State Board of Elections website.

• How many of these ballots contained the actual voting information, i.e., how people voted?

**Answer:** Again, Ballots **are not** sent to the North Carolina State Board of Elections.

• Who designed the software that was loaded onto the local voting machines?

**Answer:** Election Systems & Software

• What software was used to transfer vote tabulation data from Haywood County to the State?

**Answer: Statewide Election Information Management System (SEIMS)** 

What election officials, outside of Haywood County have access to how people voted on their ballots?

Answer: None

• Is voting information transferred over the Internet?

**Answer:** Only **Vote Totals** uploaded electronically
