**Subject:** Haywood County Board of Elections Meeting Public Comment, 4/13/2021.

During the first week in March, 2021, inspired by Trump's speech at CPAC, I spoke with Jeremy Fish at the Haywood County Board of elections. I requested that Jeremy sit down with me and explain the entire process of how my vote in November 2020 finally wound up at the State Board of Elections. I wanted to be able to explain to someone how this process works, and the only people in Haywood County that can do this are sitting in the Haywood County Board of Elections office. I requested a live demonstration with actual voting machines. At that point, Jeremy summoned **Robert Inman**, who practically had a heart attack when I explained what I wanted. **Robert Inman** wanted to know why I was asking.

As an example, I brought with me a voting ballot from NCHA (National Cutting Horse Association), curiously, an organization **Robert Inman** was familiar with. Being a member of NCHA, I had received a ballot to vote for directors located in North Carolina. I could vote by mail-in ballot or on-line. I was provided with a VOTER ID (8087397) and PASSWORD (BF9VYP). The tear-off ballot contained the PASSWORD! This meant that everyone would know who I voted for. Both of these documents are being included in your documentation package.

I voted on October 20, 2020, during Early Voting, also known as One Stop Voting, in the last election. No voter ID was required. I signed the printed ONE STOP APPLICATION, then I received my printed ballot to insert into the voting machine. As I recall, the ballot had some kind of ID number printed on the ballot. I inserted the completed ballot into the scanner.

If there was a number on that ballot, that means someone could be able to determine how I voted, as was the case with the NCHA ballot. State law prevents me from ever seeing my ballot again, so the next time I vote, I am going to take a picture of the ballot before turning it in.

Donald Trump won the vote in both Haywood County and the state of North Carolina, so I am not investigating any nefarious activity, I simply want to understand how this works. My experience is that if I ask a simple question and get what I believe is a truthful response, I go away. It appears I am getting significant push-back from **Robert Inman**. So now, I intend to dig deeper, with one of the goals of my investigation being a detailed flow diagram of the election process here in Haywood County.

As some of you board members know, I can be very detailed in my investigations, as evidenced by Flow Diagrams for:

- UPDATE - Color! Anatomy of a Foreclosure. This is how it works in Haywood County courtesy of June Ray. Case files: 12SP441, 12CV1396, 13SP252. FLOW DIAGRAM, Sheet 1/7. (See Toeprint Vol. 5, Issue 4). 4/29/2014... (7 very large Sheets total), featuring **June Ray** and **Rusty McLean**, my longest and most detailed flow diagram ever.
- Investigation of Sarge's infiltration of the Glorified Dog Pound, then run by **Doyle Teague**. This one page flow diagram was my most effective, resulting in **Doyle Teague's** departure from Animal Services the very next day, September 13, 2020. He resurfaced after several months hiatus and now works here, at the Board of Elections.

Copies of both of these flow diagrams are on my website, [www.haywoodtp.net](http://www.haywoodtp.net) and included in your document package for this Public Comment.

The last set of responses for my Request for Public Information, sent to me on April 8, 2020, now posted on [www.haywoodtp.net](http://www.haywoodtp.net), make it appear that you are masters at playing stupid. These appear to me to be blow-off responses, typical of **Robert Inman**. We can go through those responses one by one if you wish.

Moving forward, there are two (2) ways we can go.

- Have Jeremy Fish provide the tutorial on the voting process in Haywood County as originally requested, i.e., following my vote and how it was processed until it finally reached the State Board of Elections, or
- My continuing to request Public Information until I feel that I have all the information I need to complete a flow diagram. I believe the former will probably be more efficient and result in taking less of your time.

Which ever works best for you.
