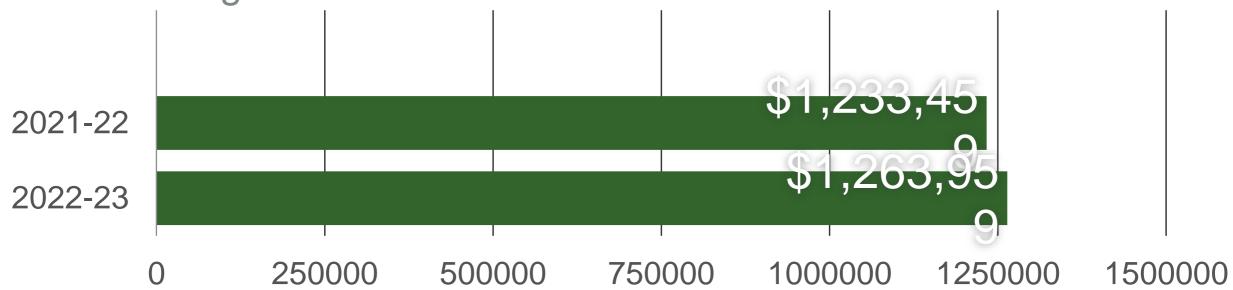

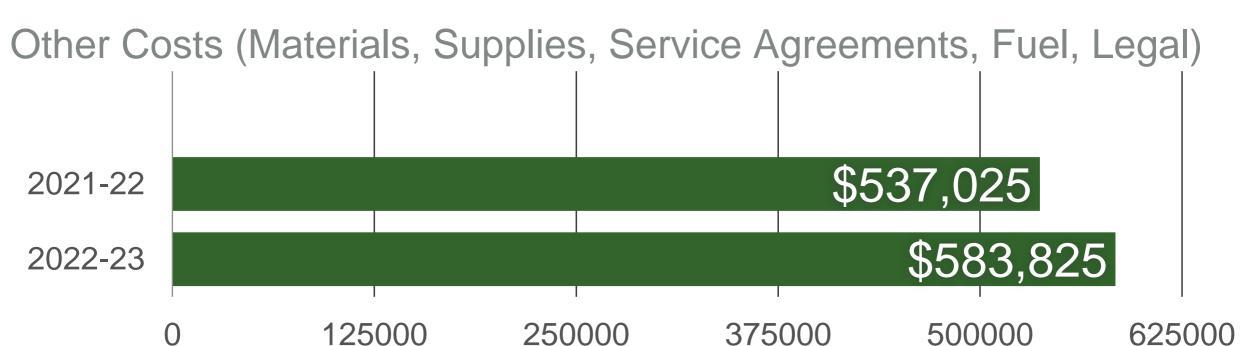

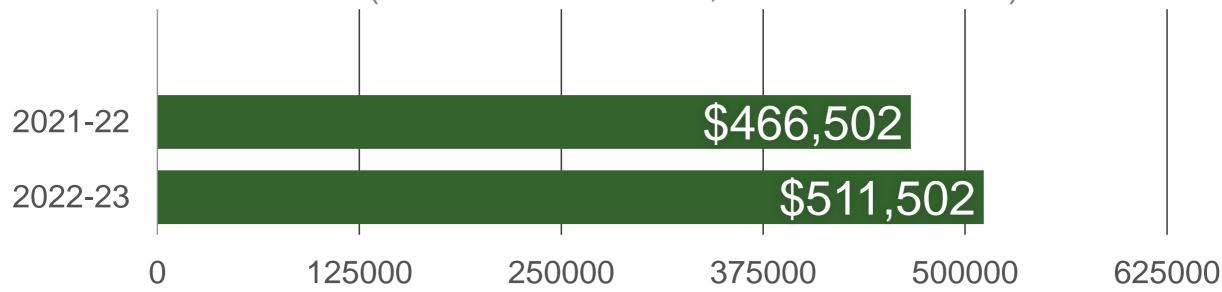

- Health Education Facility addition: increase in repairs to facilities, generator service contract, fire systems service contracts, phone service contract, waste removal contract, and pest control service agreement







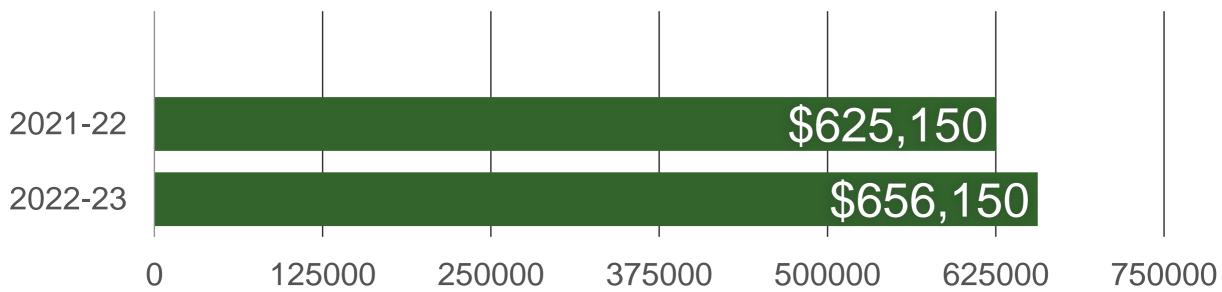

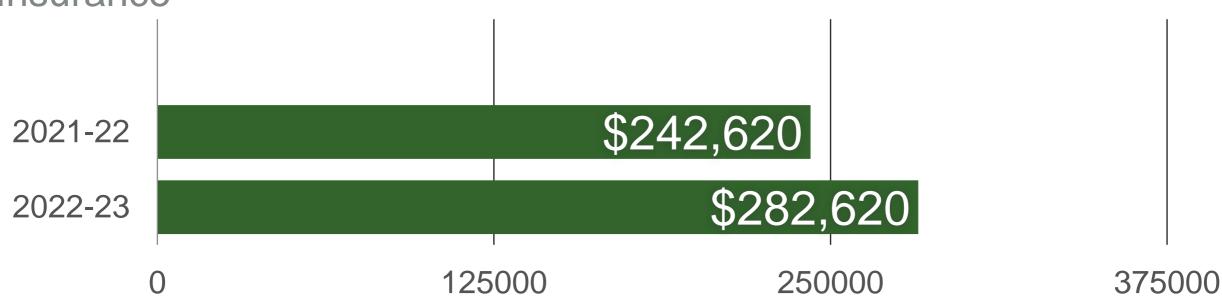

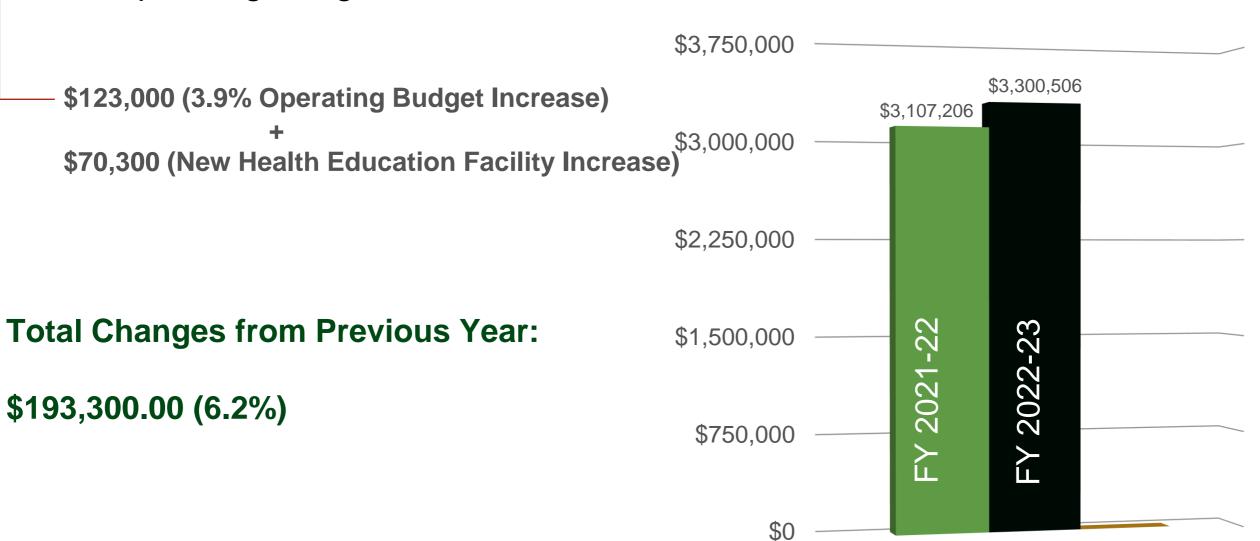

Campus Development Equipment

VenTrac Grounds Equipment - \$28,000

Replacement of existing Steiner Multi-Use Tractor, used for blowing, scraping, and brush mowing.

Campus Technology Upgrades

- Phone System Upgrade & Support \$80,000
 - Current phone system is outdated and will no longer be supported when the current contract ends in September.
 - At that time, HCC will no longer be able to receive support for the phone system when issues occur.
 - Issues could be the result of hardware failures, acts of God, software bugs, or other situations that cause the phone system to malfunction.
 - A supported phone system upgrade is critical to our operational stability.



Capital Outlay Request

Campus Technology Upgrades (cont.)

Network Infrastructure Upgrades - \$510,000

- The current network infrastructure that serves many buildings on the HCC Campus is beyond the useful life with no support options that provide hardware replacements or security updates.
- Due to the age of the current equipment, this creates challenges of technology use within the education environment that prevents effective learning as network performance is poor and wireless coverage is inadequate.
- This project will upgrade the network infrastructure of the three most student-dense buildings on campus and the administrative building, where these technology challenges are experienced the most frequently.
- The proposal is to upgrade the existing network with modern technology that will increase performance, provide better wireless coverage, and support the use of technology in the learning environment in a more desirable way.



Capital Outlay Request

Campus Technology Upgrades

o Camera Network Video Recorder - \$30,000

- The current video storage for the college does not meet industry standards in regards to the appropriate frame rate needed for proper video surveillance, which creates issues with missing sequences within recorded videos.
- The network video recorder will allow video to be recorded and stored optimally to better meet the surveillance & security needs at the college.
