

I concur.

I had just made a decision to do one of the things I hate to do most - that is, transcribe Tommy Long's, Kevin "Adjudication" Ensley's and Jennifer Best's comments made in the constituent concerns portion of the 3/20/2023 county commission meeting. Tommy Long is a sick son-of-a-bitch. The only other county commissioner that told a Haywood County Citizen to take a hike out of the county in my memory was James Weaver "Kirk" Kirkpatrick the III, and Haywood County Voters threw him out of office at the last election.

During another portion of the meeting, Kris Boyd requested the bid of \$28.1 Million Dollars from Hickory Construction Company for the New Detention Center be refused. You know, one of the principle reasons for adding cells to the current detention center was that it filled frequently, and it cost the county \$\$ to house them in other counties. I never got a handle on exactly what those costs were. That could be used as justification for the expansion, i.e., ROI (Return On Investment). A decent ROI is from 3-4 years, the amount of time you start to get a return on your investment made.

So, Vicki Hyatt quoted Bryant Morehead that when asked how much was this last year, Morehead responded with \$33,000, + travel expenses/time. WTF?

Let's compute ROI based on \$33K per year versus the cost of the new expansion of \$28.1M.

(\$28.1M)/(\$33K/year) = 852 years

WTF?

Eddie, you and I, along with everyone else would have turned to dust.

Let's suppose it costs the Sheriff's Office \$1,000,000 / year to house detainees outside the county. (That is a sizable portion of the Sheriff's budget). Let's compute ROI.

(\$28.1M)/(\$1,000,000/year) = 28 years. Eddie, I think both of us will still be dust at that point.
