NARRATIVE	Narrative												
	On July 29, 2023 I met with the Town of Waynesville Assistant Town Manager, Jesse Fowler.												
	Fowler stated that the town was notified on July 14th, 2023 about an incident that occurred at the Waynesville Recreation Center. Fowler stated that he looked into the incident, including viewing video footage, and speaking with employee's whom were present at the time. Fowler stated that he did not observe anything out of the ordinary, but wanted to forward the information to the police department.												
	I, spoke with Assistant Town Manager Fowler about a report I took earlier in the week on July 18th, in regards to a similar incident at the Waynesville Recreation Center. Fowler and I met at the Waynesville Recreation Center to review video footage from July 12, 2023 and July 18, 2023.												
	Assistant Town Manager Fowler and I first reviewed the video from July 12, 2023 starting from around 9:00am. At 9:09am a subject enters the lobby of the Waynesville Recreation Center, wearing what appears to be a swimsuit cover and sandals. While in the lobby the subject speaks with employee's at the front desk and purchases a day pass to the Waynesville Recreation Center. The subject asks about the pool area and then explains that they identify as Transsexual and asked which locker room they should use. The employee stated there was a private family locker room, and asked if they felt comfortable using it and then pointed in the direction of the locker room. The subject goes directly to the pool area where they undress and

start swimming. At one point they exit the pool area and go to the family locker room. During this time no one is seen entering or exiting the family locker room except the one subject. The subject returns to the pool area where they swim and enter and exit the sauna. The subject then puts their swim cover back on and leaves the Waynesville Recreation Center at 9:58am.

Assistant Town Manager Fowler and I then review the video from July 18, 2023, starting from around 9:40am. The same subject from July 12, enters the lobby of the Waynesville Recreation Center at 9:45am. The subject stops at the front desk and then goes directly to the family locker room. Less than one minute later the subject goes into the pool area and takes off what appears to be a swim cover and enters the pool to swim laps. The subject is seen leaving the pool area and walking into the family locker room at 10:00am. Approximately two minutes later the subject leaves the family changing area and returns to the pool area where they enter and exit the sauna and pool over the next several minutes. At 10:09am the subject gets into the pool and a female, identified as [redacted] enters the sauna at 10:15am. The subject gets out of the pool and enters the sauna at 10:21am. At this time it is reported that [redacted] has a conversation with the subject about the location of a water fountain is located. The subject exits the sauna, stops at the water fountain, then enters the family locker room. Approximately two minutes later the subject returns to the pool deck where it appears they put a swim cover back on and then leaves the Waynesville Recreation Center at 10:32am.
