
Subject: 23cvd845 - Cory Vaillancourt 50-c, continued again (and again, and again...).

- Discussion about continuing the case. Settling on a date who is the Judge. **Melrose** indicated there is not a judge in the county that will touch this case. (Clerks laughed).
- Judge Paksoy dialoged with Terry Ramey on a variety of topics, discovery, Fred Moody passing away, not receiving material from Terry's Subpoena, including never getting the video of Cory recording of Terry, procedural steps for next hearing, etc...
- Date finally decided of October 27, 2023, a Friday. Clerks looked busy coming up with a new date, because it had to be a traveling judge.
- The judge encouraged Terry if there were any date conflicts with Commissioner Ramey and the new hearing date, that he talk directly with **Melrose**, and instructed **Melrose** to accommodate Terry.
