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As your Mayor, it is important that citizens get factual and verifiable information. Lately, there has been a lot of distorted "facts," "statistics," and "statements" that range from misdirection to outright falsehoods. For some, there is confusion as to what has occurred, and even more questions as to the punishment handed out from Representative Pless and the North Carolina House of Representatives.

Several terms have been incorrectly thrown about and misrepresented. Those are Comprehensive Plan, Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) and Moratorium. Contrary to what some have said, the Comprehensive Plan and Unified Development Ordinance were both mandated to be updated by the NC General Assembly. The Comprehensive Plan is a fluid (changeable) document that is a vision for growth. The UDO contains most local regulations concerning the use and development of land and buildings, including zoning, subdivision, and stormwater that help a local government respond to the way development occurs. A moratorium definition; a temporary prohibition of an activity. Please note, the definition states temporary, not permanent.

At the August 17, 2021, at the Board of Alderman meeting, campgrounds came up for a vote. Developments deemed RV/PUD (Planned Unit Development) shall be limited to Class A, B, and C Recreational Vehicles. This RV/PUD was a new Special Exception added to the UDO and was voted on four to one. Mayor Mike Eveland was the only one voting against.

Reminder August 17, 2021, was the same day of the flood in Haywood county. The area that was hit hard that day included trailers and campgrounds in the Cruso area. The election of 2021 had two seats open for Alderman. The main topic **Campgrounds and so-called RV parks**. The voters of Maggie Valley voted loud and clear, no new campgrounds on Soco and Moody Farm roads. There were already nine campgrounds on Soco road in a two-mile stretch.

By January 2022 at least five RV/ PUD campgrounds were granted in the Maggie Valley town limits with the possibility of more coming. The new Board of Alderman needed time to finish the updated new UDO that had been worked on since 2015. This legal moratorium declared a six month hold on new requests for campgrounds, RV parks, RV-PUDS. The intent of this moratorium would allow the Board of Alderman to make findings of fact, review current laws and ordinances of other local governments, and receive public comment to identify changes to development regulations associated with Campgrounds/RVs. The vote was approved by a 3 to 2 vote. Any property owner that had already been approved for a RV-PUD was not impacted then nor when the board approved an updated UDO in June of 2022.

In Early July of this year, NC House Bill 184 was passed in the House of Representatives. House Bill 184 prohibits the town leaders of Maggie Valley from enacting a moratorium, prohibits downzoning without the consent of all property owners and does not allow the town to enforce its zoning rules in the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ). Representative Pless sponsored "NC House Bill 184". Pless did this, with the help of two Alderman, to punish Maggie Valley because your Board passed the Moratorium nineteen months ago and updated and approved a new UDO thirteen months ago. These folks were also upset that this Board passed an updated Comprehensive Plan (Land Use Plan) in June of this year.

As your Mayor, I assure you, **The Town Of Maggie Valley is still open for business!** Because of HB 184, the board of Alderman have stopped any work on keeping up the UDO. The town continues to have new interest in developments coming to the town. HB 184 has caused the town to spend more on legal fees and the employees of the town are having to work extra hard now. Please reach out and thank an employee of Maggie Valley, Your support is important to these folks who work hard each day to give you the service you deserve.

The real cost of HB 184 is to the landowners. The town of Maggie Valley no longer has a voice in how land outside of town limits is developed. **Your rights and protections on property rights should not end at your property line.** Smart, reasonable, zoning protects the value of your home. The election in November of 2021 mattered. This election on November 7, 2023 is critical to the future of Maggie Valley. Please get out and vote this November for those of us that value your ideas and concerns.
