\$12M Library Renovation?

One of James Weaver "Kirk" Kirkpatrick the III ambitions in life, other than the Super-Duper Sports Complex, was to renovate the Haywood County Library. Every time a renovation is mentioned, the costs jump by \$2 Million Dollars. It started at a modest \$4Million, and Bryant Morehead announced at the last county commission meeting that this back burner project, with this can continuously being kicked down the road, will be anywhere between \$8 - \$10 Million, up to \$12 Million, as he gave a preview of the 2023-2024 Budget to county commissioners.

Although his proposed budget does not indicate \$12 Million, you can hear it on the video of the meeting.

There is a rich history of the constantly increasing proposed cost for this library, which seems to increase by an increment of \$2 Million any time anyone mentions this project. Pretty soon, it will approach the original cost of the New Detention Center proposal, which was \$16 Million.
